

Assessment of Student Learning Outcomes

Note: This report is based upon data gathered in May of 2025 for BSW students graduating in the AY 2024-2025 Academic Year.

All social work programs accredited by the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE) are required to assess and publicly report student learning outcomes. These outcomes are based on the nine social work competencies outlined in the CSWE Accreditation Standards. These competencies represent essential dimensions of social work practice that all social work students are expected to master during their professional education. CSWE requires programs to use standardized reporting forms to support evaluation of compliance with accreditation standards. The relevant 2022 EPAS standards include:

- **Standard 5.0.1(c):** The program provides summary data and outcomes for the assessment of each of its competencies, identifying the percentage of students achieving each benchmark.
- **Standard 5.0.1(d):** The program posts its most recent summary of outcomes on its website using the format provided in the 2022 Accreditation Standards Template for Assessment of Student Learning Outcomes (AS B5.0.1(d) and/or AS M5.0.1(d)). These postings must be updated at least once every two years.

Each social work program establishes a benchmark for demonstrating competency. A score at or above the benchmark is considered evidence that a student has achieved mastery of that competency. At the University of Colorado Colorado Springs (UCCS), both the Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) and Master of Social Work (MSW) programs have set their benchmark at 80%—meaning 80% of students must meet or exceed the expected level of performance for a competency in order for that competency to have been achieved programmatically.

In accordance with EPA 2022 Standard 5.0.1(d), publicly posted assessment outcomes are updated at least once every two years to reflect results from the most recent academic years. This report is for Academic Year 2024-2025 for the BSW program.
