* Course Format Descriptions

- **Hybrid** – Course uses a combination of in-person and online instruction, with the majority of the instruction being conducted online. All students attend in-person instruction together during the scheduled class time. The balance of the course is conducted online at no scheduled time (asynchronous).
- **HyFlex** – Course uses a combination of asynchronous online instruction and real-time (synchronous) instruction attended in person or virtually.
- **In Person** – All instruction is in person on campus in a classroom with a specified meeting time. The instructor may also use the online Canvas course shell for assignments and/or readings and other course materials.
- **Online Asynchronous** – Course is conducted online at no scheduled time (asynchronous). All instruction is fully online including discussions, activities, group work and peer interaction. Online courses carry a \$100 online course fee.
